We have a lot of **fun activities** planned, along with some **amazing service projects** that benefit a host of great local organizations and ministries.

This year - we do have an attendance cap, so please return your fully completed forms AND payment to your pastor ASAP to reserve and ensure your spot(s).

Schedule

This year, we will be hosting 6 Tuesday events – June 13, 20 & 27 + July 11, 18 & 25

Transportation

As in past years, transportation for each program day will be provided by chartered school bus.

Re. Fun Events

The fun event for each week will be announced the DAY BEFORE by noon (i.e., Monday).

Because some fun events can only be done "weather permitting," the pastors *reserve the right to amend* the fun event *without advance notice*.

If a change to fun event is made, parents will be provided with an updated itinerary for the day.

"Fun" events, we anticipate enjoying this summer include:

- movie day at a local theater;
- Lilliput (unlimited go-karts, mini-golf, bumper boats);
- Zero Gravity Trampoline Park (unlimited ropes course, jumping, and laser tag);
- Two-Bit Game Room (unlimited play);
- Grand Slam (minigolf, batting cates, bumper cars, laser-tag and 1 hour arcade card)
- Lake Elmo Filtered Pool and Beach (*lifequards will be on duty*)

Cost

Appreciating busy summer schedules, John1516s offers TWO fee options this summer:

- \$125/youth for 4–6 program days
- \$75/youth for 1-3 program days

Fees include: transportation, lunch (i.e., entrée, chips & drink) + admission to fun events.

b) John1516s is **unable to <u>refund</u> fees** for missed program days.

Phone Use Guidelines

John1516s operates by the following philosophy: "When we play, we play. When we serve, we serve. When we worship, we worship." When we serve, play, and worship, we want to give our full attention to each activity.

To help with that, and to make the program as enjoyable as it can be for everyone, we will *ONLY allow phone use* on the BUS, at LUNCH, and at FUN events.

If the pastors see phones used at any other time, we will **FIRST ask** for them to be **put away immediately.**

A **SECOND** infraction – will result in **contact with a parent** and **may result** in parental need to **early pick-up** from activity site.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up

Each program day will START and END at BETHEL Lutheran Church (670 W Wheelock Pkwy, St. Paul)

Please DROP-OFF your youth between 8:15 and 8:30am.

Please note...If you are running late, please call/text one of the pastors.

Please PICK-UP your youth at Bethel at 4:15pm.

While the pastors understand work commitments & traffic delays...

...please note – the pastors are REQUIRED to STAY with your child until picked up and cannot return to their other duties until this is accomplished. Your timeliness in pick-up is therefore most appreciated!

Alternate Persons Picking-Up

Because the safety of your child(ren) is the highest concern for the pastors, your child(ren) will **ONLY BE RELEASED** for pick-up to you (as the parent signing the permission form) and/or **ANY OTHER ADULT YOU NOTE on this form.**

Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES will youth be released for pick-up to **ANYONE NOT NOTED** on your permission form!

Should an emergency require an alternate person picking-up OTHER than those listed on your permission form **YOU** (as the parent of record) MUST CONTACT one of the pastors **BY VOICE** call, **THEN by electronic note** (email or text) [i.e., two-step verification] to authorize alternate pick-up.

Adult Guest Attendees

John1516s encourages and welcomes adult guests (e.g., parents, grandparents, etc.) to attend program activities.

Adult guest attendees are asked to pay for the events in which they wish to participate.

Because the safety of our youth is paramount, all adults must:

- ...complete a background check through Bethel Lutheran once for the 2023 summer season;
- ...this check must be successfully completed by the *THURSDAY BEFORE attendance* (i.e., 5 days prior) at your first activity for the 2023 season;

- ...while we recognize adults undergo background checks for a variety of activities, John1516s
 cannot accept checks done for other programs and/or through other vetting organizations;
- ...the **cost** to complete a background check is **\$9**, payable to "Bethel Lutheran".
